of horses Cattle hogs Sheep &c together with all my  
household and kitchen furniture also all my plantation  
ion utensils induring of her natural life and after  
her Decease for my well beloved son Moses Cochran  
to have my Grist mill with full priviledge to get  
timber any where on my land to keep the same in  
repair untill William Anderson Cochran son of my  
son James Cochran Decd, shall come of age or to  
the age of twenty one years old at which time my  
son Moses Cochrans wright to sd Grist mill  
shall cease and all the tract of land together with  
the Grist mill on which I now live supposed to  
contain two hundred acres be the same more or less to  
be enjoyed by him ~~forever~~ the said William Anderson  
Cochran forever, but with this reserve that my  
son Moses Cochran Junr shall have the privi-  
ledge of holding the above named tract of land oft-  
er his mothers Decease untill the above named  
William Anderson Cochran shall come of age  
but the sd Moses Cochran Junr shall not be  
allowed to Commit any waste by cutting more  
than is necessary for keeping the said plantation  
in good repair, and after my wife Elisabeths  
Decease I Give and bequeeth to my well beloved  
daughter Susanna Aubrey one Cow if any there  
should be, and all the rest of my estate if any =

there should be stock of all nature and kind soever  
also all my household and kitchen furniture together  
with my plantation interests and all and every part  
of my estate both real and personal if any there  
should be after my wife Elisabeths Decease I Give  
to my well beloved son Moseph Cockram Esq<sup>r</sup> to  
be by him and his heirs enjoyed forever —  
and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my  
son Moseph Cockram Esq<sup>r</sup> & Cattel Smith ex-  
=cutors to this my last will and testament read-  
=ing all former wills by me made in testimony  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
affixed My seal this Twentysifth Day of February  
in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred
